Crime 1: Using the incorrect form of **to**, **too**, or **two**.

Crime 2: Using the incorrect form of **their**, **there**, or **they're**.

Crime 3: Mixing up **then** and **than**.

Crime 4: Forgetting to underline, *italicize*, or capitalize the title of a book.

Crime 5: Forgetting to capitalize the first word of a sentence or a proper noun.

Crime 6: Forgetting to use end punctuation.

Crime 7: Using the incorrect form of **its** or **it's**.
